




Campion Trail North

At seven miles, Campion Trail North is the longest continuous trail in Irving and one of the longest in the Dallas area. Funded by both Dallas County and the City of Irving, the twelve-foot-wide trail extends from Valley Ranch to the offices of Las Colinas and provides the opportunity to safely run, walk, skate, or bike to work. The trail also winds in and out of trees, offers views of the Trinity River, and features drinking fountains, covered picnic pavilions and three separate paved parking lots along the way.


